

Class Report

The class started with an introduction of Apte Kaka Sir, and then we all sang the national anthem, which was a heartfelt experience. This set a meaningful tone for the session. Sir then proceeded to discuss awareness on various topics related to donation.

He told us about the utility of donations, explaining the importance of organ donation, including organs like the heart, lungs, kidneys, liver, and pancreas. He highlighted the different types of donations, such as *deceased donation* and *living donation*.

Sir discussed the requirements for organ donation, emphasizing that it is crucial for saving lives. He also explained the process of *pledge registration*, which can be done voluntarily through websites like NOTTO (National Organ and Tissue Transplant Organisation), or through medical colleges, eye banks, and skin banks.

The session aimed to educate us about these critical topics, encouraging us to consider our role in making informed decisions and potentially saving lives through donation

He emphasized the significance of specific donations, such as:

- ***Cornea Donation***: Donated corneas can restore vision in individuals suffering from corneal blindness. Corneas are preserved in eye banks for transplantation.
- ***Skin Donation***: Donated skin can be used for grafting in burn patients, aiding in their recovery and reducing scarring. Specifically, skin donation involves removing the outer layer (about 0.3mm thick) and sometimes a second layer, which can be used for grafting.
- ***Body Donation (Cadavers)***: Donated bodies can be used for medical education and research, playing a vital role in training healthcare professionals.


Sir stressed the importance of registering a pledge to donate, encouraging us to take an active role in this life-saving process. He highlighted the impact that donation can have on recipients and their families.







Report on World Diabetes Day

To raise the public awareness, PCMC INS YCMH observed a World Diabetes Day on 14th November 2025. The day is observed annually to raise awareness about diabetic issues and promote better care for overall well-being. The first World Diabetes Day was celebrated and observed on 14 November 1991.

The main aim of the day was a reminder to everyone around the world to take care of health. " Diabetes Across Life Stages" Was the theme of World Diabetes Day 2025.

This day was observed at College Building, 3rd floor Classroom under the guidance of Dr. Mrs. Kavita kelkar, Principal, Institute Of Nursing Sciences, YCMH and organised by first year Bsc Nursing students, supported and guided by Mrs. Shraddha Mam And other faculty members.

Aryan Udage a student of 1st year Bsc Nursing, welcomed, Dr. Rajas Ma'am by giving a welcome speech, later on she continued by giving introduction and information about the reason behind celebrating this day. First ma'am highlighted the theme of the day that Diabetes can affect anyone - Children, Adults and older people also and ensured us about importance of prevention, early detection and proper care throughout every phase of life. She explained the type of diabetes such that first type of diabetes is diabetes insipidus which is related to insulin hormone and second type is diabetes mellitus in which polyuria occurs means extra micturition. After that she suggested best class of oral diabetes medication these are Biguanides and sulfonylureas. Biguanides which decrease hepatic gluconeogenesis, increase insulin sensitivity and reduce intestinal glucose absorption and sulfonylureas which increase glucose dependent insulin secretion and promote side effects of that medication. More consumption of sugar products leads to more chances for diabetes so she suggested to take limited amounts of sugar in our diet. When we have to measure insulin level then choose right insulin syringe, there are two types one is red and other is orange. The red syringe measures up to 40 unit/ml of insulin level while orange syringe measures up to 100 unit/ml of insulin level. She also shared experience of insulin injections technique which is used at the time when diabetes is initially detected to fastly maintain the proper range of insulin. Later on, she explained the symptoms of patients which has hypoglycemia and hyperglycemia. In hypoglycemia the patients get sweating, feels hungry, cannot focus on anything, feels sleepy and gets irritated by anything without any serious reasons. In hyperglycemia dry mouth, thirst, weakness, headache, blurred vision, frequent urination. And signs includes black patches on neck, elbow, knee and groin regions.

After the lecture gets over then, Ayush Meshram asked question on- Diet of diabetic patients, ma'am answered that avoid extra sweets, bakery products, take small amount of meals, drink plenty of water, exercise 30-40 minutes daily. Secondly Devesh Sonune asked another question that Is there complete cure of diabetic patients? She answered that there is no complete permanent cure for diabetes but many patients especially with type 2 diabetes can achieve normal sugar levels without medicines because of weight loss, diet control, regular exercise. At last she said if we do regular exercise, proper intake of diet, stress management and consumption of limited sugar, then we will never suffer from diabetes.

The blood donation camp was students with faculty, staff and students of PCMC INS YCMH.







